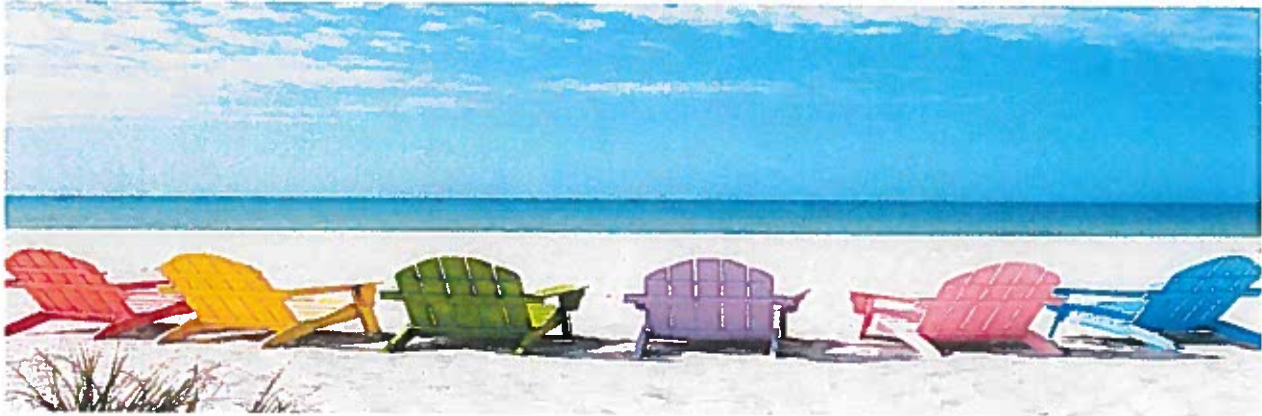
Let us not forget to help in the watering of our Project Color My Rankin. The planters at the Bicentennial Park need watering frequently.

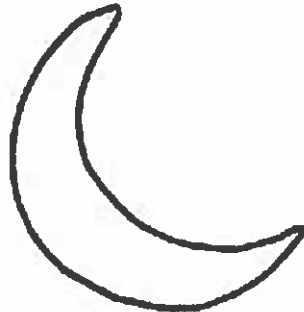
