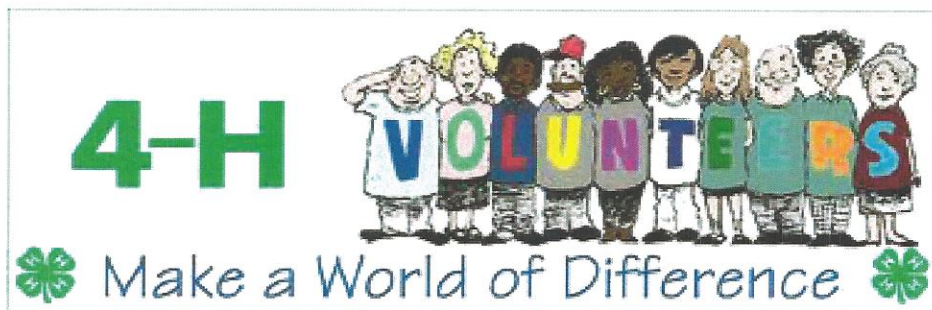
Consumer Decision Making (CDM) Team Sign-Up

4-H'ers are needed to make a team for Juniors, Intermediates, and Seniors to compete in the CDM contest. 4-H'ers are given a scenario, and they are to evaluate four different kinds of the same item (example: tennis shoes and computers). Then they place them as first to fourth best buy for the scenario. If you are interested in trying this contest, contact the Extension Office to sign up.

Participants learn to make wise decisions about their valuable resources. Project activities also focus on decision making, understanding the economy and how it affects consumer decisions, money management, consumer rights and responsibilities, and how consumer decisions affect the environment.

The District 6 4-H CDM contest is set for Saturday, May 2nd, in Ft. Stockton.
